

Home church service of GCLC: A new beginning



The home church service of GCLC started at brother Manmath and sister Rebeka's house on Easter Sunday this year. Even as Rebeka and Manmath started the home church last month, their journey started much earlier. In 2015, when they were new to GCLC, a prophecy was spoken over them that people would come to know the Lord through their lives. For a while, nothing seemed to unfold. But in 2018, after much prayer and at the request of an UESI staff, they started a Bible Study in their home.

Faithfulness and obedience

Initially, only one person attended, and discouragement crept in. Yet, they sensed the Lord asking them to remain faithful. In obedience, they continued—and in time, the Lord began to move. Their landlord's daughter, Gursharan, had earlier experienced deliverance from oppressive dreams through a time of prayer held in their home by members of the church.
