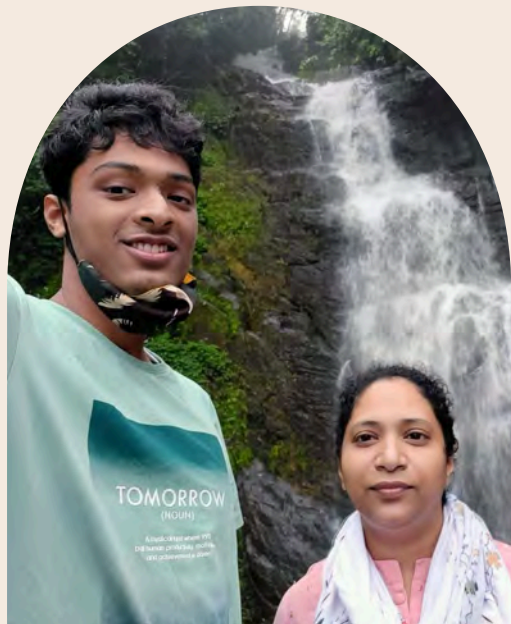


## *The faith that formed me*
