A life of trust in God's working – Believers are called to acknowledge God's hand in every season—good or bad—because He is the One who works all things together for our good according to His purpose.

We may not always understand why God leads us down certain paths, especially those we would never choose for ourselves. Yet, our sovereign God knows what is best for His children. In His love, He directs our steps. When we learn to walk in the way He sets before us, the outcome is always victorious, blessed, and fragrant—because we have chosen to accept His will and His leading.



A seat, a story, a miracle: Trusting God in the waiting!

I thank God for giving me the opportunity to share a glimpse of His goodness in my life. I am also grateful to our senior pastor, all the pastors, and my church family for your prayers, guidance, and encouragement.

Earlier this year, I appeared for the NEET exam and qualified. However, my score was not sufficient to secure a seat in the college I had hoped for. I decided to take a year off to prepare again and improve my score, but I also wanted to make good use of my gap year. That's when I applied



for admission to Delhi University, with my first choice being Psychology at Jesus and Mary College (JMC).

After giving the CUET, I submitted my preference list, and soon after, I was invited for an interview at JMC. On the morning of the interview, I felt a heavy sense of fear and anxiety that I could not shake off, even after praying. Just ten minutes before the interview, my sister sat with me and praye, thanking God and declaring His goodness. As I joined her in that moment, the anxiety that had gripped me suddenly lifted. God gave me peace, and I was able to attend the interview with a calm heart.

Although the interview was brief and left me uncertain, I waited and trusted God. When the first round of seat allocation was released, I saw the words: No seat allocated. Naturally, I was disappointed, but I remained hopeful. However, I soon discovered I had made a mistake while filling out my forms, which further affected my chances. That one error weighed heavily on me, and I struggled with doubt. Yet in the midst of it, I felt a quiet joy which was God's reminder not to give up.

When the second round came, I prayed fervently for Psychology at JMC. At 5 p.m., when the results were released, once again the words appeared: No seat allocated. I broke down. I wasn't angry with God, but I told Him honestly, "Jesus, I have no more hope left." It felt like every door had closed. I went to sleep with a very heavy heart that night.

The next morning, while still discouraged, my sister came in and said, "Chutki, you got Psychology in JMC." At first I didn't believe her, but when I checked the official site, there it was my first preference, with a button that read Accept. I had gone to bed thinking it was over, but God had already written a different ending.

This reminded me of the miracle at Cana, where the best wine was saved for last. When we come to the end of ourselves, God steps in and fills our emptiness with something greater than we could imagine. His grace is never lacking; it is always more than sufficient.

Truly, God is not a God of hopelessness, He is the God of hope. Even when we feel weak or lost, He is still working in ways we may not yet see.

I thank my church family for praying with me and for me. I thank the pastors, elders, the GANG, my friends, and my family for their constant love and support. Above all, I thank God not just for the seat I received, but for drawing me closer to Him in the waiting.

I leave you with this verse that carried me through:

"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit." -Romans 15:13 (NIV)
