PASTORS' PERSPECTIVE

Dear GCLC family,

The promise verse for October is – *“Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth.”* (Psalm 46:10, NIV)

Different translations bring out the richness of this verse in unique ways:

“Step out of the traffic! Take a long, loving look at Me, your High God, above politics, above everything.” (The Message)

“Stop your striving and recognize that I am God! I will be exalted over the nations; I will be exalted over the earth.” (NET)

“Be still, and know that I am God! I will be honored by every nation. I will be honored throughout the world.” (NLT)

What a timely promise for us today! In a world of turmoil and fear, God calls His people to pause, to rest, and to recognize His sovereignty. True peace cannot be found outside of Him.

This psalm reflects God's word to King Hezekiah when Assyria threatened Judah. Instead of fighting in fear, Hezekiah trusted God—and one angel defeated the mighty army. That is our God!

From this, we are reminded:

- God's people respond differently to crises than the world does—we turn to Him.
- Our experiences with Him teach us to expect His fresh and surprising ways of deliverance. Sometimes He speaks audibly, other times in silence—but He always speaks.

A STORY OF GOD’S FAITHFULNESS: THE JOURNEY OF GCLC

The story of Global Christian Life Center (GCLC) begins on 3 October 1982, when a small group gathered in the living room of Rev. Coleman’s home in Geetanjali Enclave. Led by Rev. and Mrs. Doyle Oliver, only seven people attended that first service—but it was the beginning of something God had planned long before.

In the years that followed, the fellowship grew, and with it came many changes. In 1984, Pastors Tuttle and Jeyaraj renamed the Church Central Assembly of God (CAG) so it could be better rooted in its local setting. From one home to another, from Defence Colony to Akbar Hotel, the congregation kept moving to make space for more people. Each new venue carried with it stories of God’s faithfulness, fellowship, and growth.

At the Akbar Hotel, surrounded by embassies and international visitors, the seed of a global Church was planted. Potluck dinners, worship, and the warmth of community made CAG a place where people found “a home away from home.” In time, this global heart was fully embraced, and the name changed to Global Christian Life Center (GCLC). On 31 May 1986, God opened the door for something greater—the purchase of a permanent building in South Extension–Part II. After much prayer and preparation, the renovated site, known as L16, was dedicated on 21 January 1988. At that time, the hall seated 200, but fewer than 60 attended regularly. Some doubted whether it would ever be filled.

In His faithfulness, God moved in a powerful way. In 1989, revival broke out. What seemed impossible became a reality as attendance grew to nearly 1,500. Worship that was alive with the Spirit, and the power of God’s Word, drew people in. The little fellowship that began in a living room had now become a thriving, Spirit-filled Church, a testimony to God’s goodness and faithfulness.

THE LORD IS OUR EBENEZER

In September 1991 when we first walked into the Central Assemblies of God Church, we were just a young couple with a one-month-old baby, Jeremiah, in our arms. We had no idea then of the incredible journey God was about to take us on. Today, with hearts full of gratitude, we look back and can only say: God has been faithful every step of the way.

Our children grew up in the Church, hand in hand with the children of Rev. Robert, Pastor John Cyriac, and Rev. Ivan Powar. Together they laughed, played, had sleepovers, parties, picnics, dinners and created precious memories that still bring joy to our hearts.

For 34 years, we have had the privilege of serving Him—among the youth, in the worship team, and through the many crusades and outreaches. We were part of the great revival of 1997, when God moved so powerfully that lives were changed forever. Those were days when heaven truly touched earth.

1994 -The greatest treasure of all has been witnessing God's hand over our family and our Church. One of the earliest miracles came during the very first Miracle Night in 1994. Our second son, John, was 4 months old and suffering from a severe stomach ailment. That first night, the Lord touched him, and he was completely healed. From then on, our faith in the God who heals and restores became unshakable.

In 2002 - we opened our home for a small weekly Bible study. At the time, the Sector-21 crossing was notorious for fatal accidents. Many feared the place, believing the Pipal tree in the midst of the road carried evil spirits. Our men's fellowship prayed faithfully every Tuesday morning at that very junction. Within just two months, the number of accidents dropped by nearly 80%. God showed us once again that only prayer can change the atmosphere. What began humbly in our living room slowly grew to 20 families, and today we rejoice to see a vibrant fellowship blossomed into a full evening Church service at Don Bosco Office, Dwarka, faithfully shepherded by the Pastors of GCLC.

2005, Pastor Robert was led to begin a morning service for believers in Gurgaon and Dwarka, which began at the Ryan International School, Vasant Kunj. A handful of families—Henry & Patricia D'Souza and ourselves and Auntie & Uncle IW Paul stood together with Pastor Robert Jeyaraj and Pastor Sam Vijaysenan to see this vision come alive.

2017–2020 – Pastor entrusted us with the Samalkha Church with about 10–15 people gathered there to hear the Word, and we saw lives touched and strengthened in Christ. Today we pray it comes back to life.

Looking back on this journey of more than three decades, we stand amazed. We've seen seasons of joy and seasons of trial, yet through it all, one truth remains unshaken: our God is faithful. He has been our EBENEZER.

He has led us from being young parents in 1991 to now being part of the GRANDS Club —and every chapter has been written by His grace alone.

We share our story to encourage you: No matter where you are in your journey, trust Him fully. The God who carried us will carry you too. The God who turned our small beginnings into testimonies of His power can do the same in your life. Truly, He who began a good work will be faithful to complete it.
